Please have your child bring the following supplies to the Open House. Do not label items unless indicated. Crayola is the preferred brand for art supplies-especially crayons because they last longer and their colors are "true" colors

Classroom Supplies

- A backpack labeled with your child's name
- Child-sized headphones (in a labeled ziploc bag)
- Small (8 oz or less) water bottle labeled with your child's name
- 1 box 8 count ~~large~~ crayons*
- 1 bottle of non-toxic white glue*
- AM Students-1 single colored package of cardstock (white, green, red, blue, etc...)
- PM Students-1 container of lysol wipes & 1 box of tissues

All students 1 large box or bag of snacks for recess time, i.e. Goldfish crackers, pretzels, animal crackers, cereal such as Honeycomb, Fruit Loops, Honey Nut Cheerios, Captain Crunch with Berries, pretzels, or graham crackers (generic brands are fine)
